

Women's & Children's Services: Visitation Guidelines

JMH is committed to meeting the needs of our patients while maintaining the safest possible environment for our staff and visitors. Thank you for your compliance with and understanding of these guidelines. All visitors must adhere to the following with no exceptions:

- Visitors will be asked to only visit in their assigned designated area.
- Masking is recommended but optional at this time.
- Visitors **must not visit if sick** or if they have any symptoms of illness so we can prevent the spread of infection to our patients and staff.

While Visiting on Units:

- ✓ Only visit in assigned designated area.
- ✓ Perform hand hygiene before entering/exiting facility and as needed.
- ✓ Visitor Badge **must be** visible at all times.

NICU: Neonatal Intensive Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 banded caregivers or 1 banded caregiver + 1 visitor at a time • No children except siblings 12 years and older 	24 hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only 2 visitors are allowed at the bedside, one of which must be a banded caregiver • Siblings 12 years and older may visit
PICU: Pediatric Intensive Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 caregivers + 2 visitors • No children under 12 years old except for siblings 	9am-9pm, 2 caregivers may stay overnight	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Siblings should be accompanied by a supervising adult visitor
